

LIGHT WALK ODAIBA WEBSITE POLICY

These Terms of Use shall apply to all matters arising between users and the ODAIBA Illumination Organizing Committee (hereinafter the “Committee”) in connection with the use of the Services. At LIGHT WALK ODAIBA (hereinafter the “Website”), we collect information from users of the Website only to the extent necessary for the smooth operation of the services provided (including but not limited to, providing information to users and receiving their feedback through the Website).

In collecting, using, and managing information, we will handle such information appropriately as follows, in accordance with the “Tokyo Metropolitan Ordinance on the Protection of Personal Information (Ordinance No. 113 of December 21, 1990)” (hereinafter the “Ordinance”), and we will strive to ensure that the Website can be used by users in a safe manner.

1. Copyright

If personal information is collected and such collection is carried out by the Committee or the LIGHT WALK ODAIBA Administration Office through this Website, the provision (or registration) of such information shall in principle be at the users’ discretion. When we collect personal information, we will specify the purposes of such collection. We will collect personal information to the extent necessary to achieve the specified purposes.

1) Purposes for Which Personal Information Is Used

1. To handle administrative procedures for store participation at the event;
2. To respond to inquiries sent to the LIGHT WALK ODAIBA Administration Office;
3. To provide communications and send notifications from the LIGHT WALK ODAIBA Administration Office; and
4. To conduct public relations activities (for the event or its participating stores).

2) Restrictions on Use of Personal Information

Personal information provided (or registered) by users will be used within the scope of the purposes of collection specified in advance. The Committee and the LIGHT WALK ODAIBA Administration Office will not handle such information beyond the extent necessary to achieve the purposes of such use, except as provided by law.

3) Disclosure to Outsourced Service Providers

The Committee and the LIGHT WALK ODAIBA Administration Office may outsource all or part of the handling of collected personal information to the extent necessary to achieve the purposes of use.
